๓. Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM) เป็นทุนในระดับปริญญาโท เพื่อสร้างกิจกรรมความร่วมมือ เพื่อออกแบบและจัดตั้ง joint programme
๔. Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE) เป็นทุนพัฒนาศักยภาพบุคลากรทางด้านอุดมศึกษา
๕. Jean Monnet Actions (JMA) เป็นทุนส่งเสริมการสอนและการวิจัยในสาขาเกี่ยวกับสหภาพยุโรปศึกษา (European Union studies) ในระดับอุดมศึกษา ดังมีรายละเอียดตาม QR Code ที่ปรากฏด้านล่างนี้
